One of the most common questions younger women with vasculitis ask is how the disease will affect their ability to have children. Unfortunately, there is very limited information to help answer this question.

This study will help answer this question by following pregnant women with vasculitis to discover how their vasculitis and medications impact their pregnancy.

This registry will teach us how to better manage vasculitis during pregnancy to increase pregnancy success.

This registry will be collecting information to help find answers to how vasculitis impacts reproductive health and pregnancy outcomes.

Who can participate?

Pregnant women, over age 18, with one of these diseases:

- Behçet's disease
- Central nervous system vasculitis
- Cryoglobulinemic vasculitis
- Eosinophilic granulomatosis with polyangitis (Churg- Strauss)
- Granulomatosis with polyangiitis (Wegener's)

- Henoch-Schönlein purpura (IgA vasculitis)
- Microscopic polyangiitis
- Polyarteritis nodosa
- Takavasu's arteritis
- Urticarial vasculitis
- Other types of vasculitis
