

## BVAS/GPA scoring

Scoring. In calculating the final BVAS/WG score, the number of major items (either new/worse or persistent) is multiplied by 3 and added to the total number of minor items.

$$\text{BVAS/GPA} = (\text{number of major items} \times 3) + (\text{number of minor items})$$

The maximum BVAS/WG score is 68, assuming that not more than 1 major and 1 minor “other” items are present. The BVAS/WG score ranged from 0 to 13, with a median score of 2, among the 117 clinic patients evaluated at baseline in the princeps study.
